Most of them can be found in your own backyard; I've seen most of them hanging out in tree or on the ground. (With the exception of the Canada Goose). If you get the hang of these, you'll be intrigued with birds in no time. There's a whole world outside your window! Grab a pair of binoculars and start looking!

Mourning Dove.

Phrase: hey-hey-hey-you-you-over there.



House Sparrow:

Phrase: Chirp-Chirp Chirp



Black-Capped Chickadee:

Phrase: Chicka-dee-dee-dee-dee.



Blue Jay:

Phrase: Look-at-me-look-at-me!



American Robin:

Phrase: Hello-goodbye-hello



Canada (not Canadian) Goose:

Phrase: Home- sweet- home.



NY State Bird:

Eastern Bluebird



Song Sparrow:

Phrase: Maids-maids-maids-put-on-your-tea-kettle-kettle-kettle.
